acclaim as a virtuoso on the 'oud and violin.

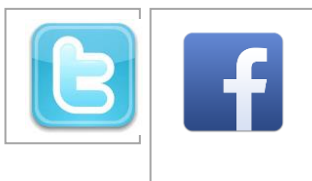
