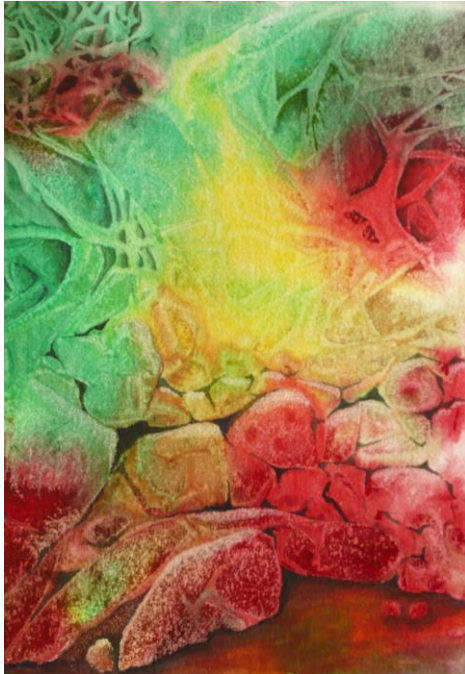

Artist of the Month – Avis Davis

“The Enchanted Forest” by Avis Davis of Spirit Lake. Using a method of pouring the watercolor onto the canvas, Avis Davis has created, “The Enchanted Forest,” which encourages the viewer to use imagination to detect hidden images. A poem which is also on display at the Red Rock Center entitled “The Enchanted Forest,” written by Avis’ daughter, Teresa, introduces visitors to the paintings. – “The idea is to read the poem and that kind of leads you into this enchanted forest. ... Each one of the titles gives you some clue as to where I was going with the painting,” she said. “I just personally love where you have a painting, and you see what it is, but there’s more — you see a lot more there when you look at it. My hope is that it draws people in and frees up their imagination a little bit, and they have a good time going off on their own little trip into the painting.” Although the paintings are a departure from Avis’ previous work, they still maintain the vibrant quality that she’s always tried to achieve.

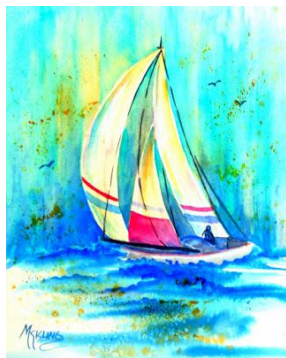

Robot Sculptures Art Class with Holly

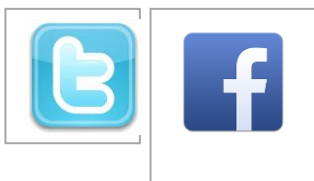
Saturday, August 23
