A multi-media exhibit revealing a lifelong interest in the visual arts and a love of late night cartoons and vampires, which is often reflected in Haley Rothstein's paintings and drawings. As a child she would create new characters, give them personalities and stories, and draw them every single day. During college she focused on the more "serious" art of photography, and received a Bachelor's degree in Art Photography from St. Cloud State University.

In 2010 Haley started painting "joyful figures" conveying a mixture of feelings – between cute and disturbing. The initial idea was of a simple monster with no face – just teeth – making the shape of a heart with its fingers. As I kept painting them, the figures became more stylized with brighter colors and happy grins.

Once again her paintings changed when she met her husband. She started surrounding herself with tree-related art, and began painting abstracted trees, sometimes with birds or people. Because she came from a military family and moved across the country a couple times, she does not recall those "Hey, remember the time..." with friends which is often reflected in her painting and drawings -- a craving for a history or "roots" someplace.
