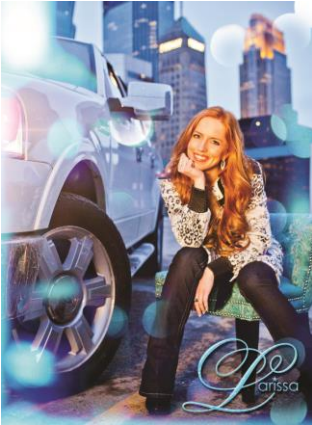
Artist of the Month Christy Gerdts and Chelsea Bell A Mother – Daughter Exhibit
