She is most happy when she is being creative. She enjoys working in a variety of mediums, with her favorite being acrylic paints, pen and ink. Outside of the typical paper and canvas she enjoys using unlikely surfaces— wood, metal, bones and more.

Sometimes she creates conjure an emotion or react to an outside stimulus, carefully selecting her medium and color palette. At other times her direction is unclear becoming more defined as time goes on. Her best work is created without a structured goal. The unexpected and unpredictable is much more exciting than a meticulously planned project as you will see in much of her work.
