This is a public event offered free of charge!

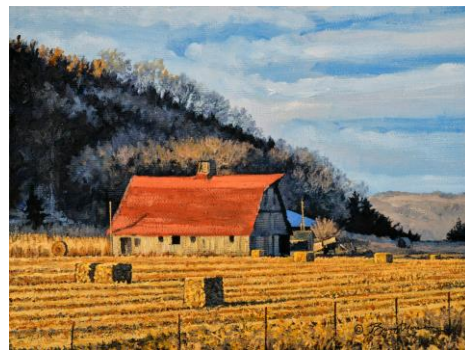
