- ORIGINALITY; NO INFRINGEMENT.** All photographs must be the original work of the applicant.
- USE OF NAME, PHOTOGRAPHS AND LIKENESS.** The winning entries will be asked to sign a photo release. By signing the release the release, winners are agreeing to allow Red Rock Center to reproduce the photo and use their names as stated in the release. Recognizable people in an image are not allowed.
- SIZE, QUALITY:** All notecard images are produced in a 5.5" x 4" format, vertical or horizontal. While each entry does not need to be submitted in that exact size, it needs to be proportional to those dimensions. Images for the August art show will be printed in an 8"x10" format. Please keep this in mind when selecting images. They must have a resolution high enough to be printed in this size.
