

## Artist of the Month: Malia Wiley “Crochet in Translation” December 4 - January 10



Malia Wiley of Lake Crystal makes her living painting pets, kids, and farm animals near and dear to people's hearts, creating a keepsake to last a lifetime. In her free time she crochets. Painting and crochet have been two creative outlets that she has pursued for most of her life and combining them only feels natural.

This body of work is inspired by the craft of crochet and started as an idea to translate the hand woven fabric into a painting. The idea quickly merged with her love for painting animals and became something totally different, pairing of an animal with an afghan into a painting. Each afghan depicted in the paintings is interesting to me because of the colors and patterns used to create them.

As the idea for these paintings developed, I let these elements, dictate to me a story and from that story a pairing of each afghan with a specific animal is revealed.

## Chubb House Christmas Tea & Bake Sale Saturday, December 1<sup>st</sup> • 11am-2pm


