Many years ago with an interest in art Susan started creating and selling charcoal portraits. She was awarded a fine arts scholarship and attended college in Cedar Falls, IA. While she was employed by Mayer Studio in Spirit Lake she learned portrait photography, and discovered photography was a much faster method than drawing. 25 years later, she opened her own portrait photography studio, Silver Shutter in Algona, IA. She then met her husband Terry and relocated her studio Fairmont. She began showing her interpreted photographs alongside Terry who was doing art shows as a jeweler who creates and makes his own designs.

The altered photographs on display were created to present at these shows. Susan used Photoshop as a medium or tool to achieve these results. For each image, she has been able to control the printing process. She also custom framed and matted the work she exhibits. Susan states if the image created produces an emotional response in the viewer she has achieved her goal.
