AMBER RAHE October's Artist of the Month



Amber Rahe creates her work out of her home studio in Mankato, Minnesota. Her current work is a two part series of paintings. The first is a series based on the process of dying and the grief and bargaining stages experienced by the ones who are left behind. The second series of ink paintings are a more intuitive and spontaneous process that came about because of the intensity of the first series. They are entirely painted with ink and include subject matter derived from nature.



Amber was born in Marshall, Minnesota. Amber's interest in art began with the creation of cartoon characters and instruction from her grandmother at an early age. She received a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in 2002 and a Master of Arts Degree in 2008 from Minnesota State University, Mankato and then moved on to receive a Master of Fine Arts degree from the University of North Dakota in 2012. She now teaches occasionally as an adjunct instructor at Minnesota State University, Mankato.
