

## Martin County Preservation Association

### Purpose and Mission

The Martin County Preservation Association was established June 12, 1992 to preserve, and make available to the public important historical buildings in Martin County. Our purpose is to not only to preserve the past, but to enhance the quality of life for many generations to come.

### Restoration Projects

In 1992 the Chubb House was acquired for \$35,000. The house was refurbished by volunteers who devoted thousands of hours to restoring the property to the historically accurate and pristine condition seen today. It is furnished with original and period furniture to add to the authenticity. Many people have donated the furniture and other items.

In 2000 MCPA took over another building formally known as the First Church of Christian Scientists. It was in extremely bad condition and ready for demolition. MCPA organized a group of highly talented and dedicated volunteers to raise a substantial amount of money. After 40,000 hours of volunteer labor and a great deal of hard work, the building and stained glass windows were restored to pristine condition. On September 16-18 2005, the building was officially dedicated to the citizens of Martin County and the City of Fairmont now known as the Red Rock Center for the Arts.

Subsequently MCPA raised \$42,000 to purchase an antique Steinway grand piano. The piano is used by musicians of all ages at the Red Rock Center for the Arts.

Both facilities are listed on the  
National Register of Historic Places.

## Chubb House

The house was built in 1867 on a hill overlooking Lake Sisseton, and is the oldest surviving house in Fairmont.

The ladies of the Chubb House hold several community Teas throughout the year. Enjoy a Stew Lamplight dinner in the fall and a Christmas Tea and Bake sale just in time for the holidays.

**Chubb House** is available to rent and is air conditioned for comfort. It provides a warm and friendly setting for intimate family gatherings, small receptions, and parties of up to 40 people. Guests can gather around the warm and friendly fireplace to relax, and to enjoy the beautiful setting with historic Lake Sisseton in the background. The back yard is suitable for picnics.
